## **Position Requirements:**

- Minimum start is at 8am on Friday morning of the program (opportunity to arrive on Thursday to get settled in)
- Minimum departure is after breakfast meds dispensed on Sunday of the program (welcome to stay through staff closing time around 1:30pm)
- Current State License for LNA, LPN or RN on file & display (does not need to be NH-specific)
- Background Check (paid for by NH Teen Institute)
- Good communication skills with adults and children
- Ability to soothe and show compassion to children who may be experiencing illness and/or homesickness (this could be their first time away from home)
- Willingness to be flexible day to day as we manage the logistics of the program
