

Jesus is God

[John 10:30](#) "I and the Father are one."

—

[Isaiah 43:10-11 \(For the JW\)](#) "You are my witnesses," declares the Lord, "and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe me and understand that I am he. **Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me. I, I am the Lord, and besides me there is no savior.** (Also, the savior is referred to as Jesus)

[John 1:1-2](#) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning.

[John 1:14](#) The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

[Isaiah 7:14](#) Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him **Immanuel** (which means "**God is here**")

—

[Psalm 102:25-27 \(Addressing God\)](#): Of old you laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. They will perish, but you will remain; they will all wear out like a garment. You will change them like a robe, and they will pass away, but you are the same, and your years have no end.

[Hebrews 1:8-12 \(Describing Jesus the same way as God\)](#)

But of the Son he says,

"Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of your kingdom. You have loved righteousness and hated

wickedness; therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness beyond your companions. **And, You, Lord, laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the work of your hands; they will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment, like a robe you will roll them up, like a garment they will be changed. But you are the same, and your years will have no end.**

[John 8:58-59](#) “Very truly I tell you,” Jesus answered, “before Abraham was born, **I am!**” At this, they picked up stones to stone him, but Jesus hid himself, slipping away from the temple grounds.

They wanted to stone Jesus because with that statement, he claimed to be God based on Moses' encounter with God.

[Exodus 3:14](#) God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: ‘**I AM** has sent me to you.’”

[John 5:18 ESV](#) This was why the Jews were seeking all the more to kill him, because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God, his own father, making himself equal with God.

[Isaiah 48:12-13 \(Addressing God\)](#) “Listen to me, O Jacob, and Israel, whom I called! I am he; **I am the first, and I am the last.** My hand laid the foundation of the earth, and my right hand spread out the heavens; when I call to them, they stand forth together.”

[Rev 1: 17-18 \(Jesus is speaking\)](#) When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand on me, saying, “Fear not, **I am the first and the last,** and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades.

Genesis 32:24 & 30 (When Jacob wrestled with God) And Jacob was left alone. And **a man** wrestled with him until the breaking of the day... So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel, saying, “For I have seen **God face** to face, and yet my life has been delivered.”

Genesis 18:1-4 “And the Lord appeared to him by the oaks of Mamre, as he sat at the door of his tent in the heat of the day. He lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, three **men** were standing in front of him. When he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them and bowed himself to the earth and said, “**O Lord**, if I have found favor in your sight, do not pass by your servant. Let a little water be brought, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree” Referring to one of the men as God.

Genesis 3:8 And they heard the sound of the **Lord God walking** in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

Jeremiah 1:1-11 Then **the Lord put out his hand and touched** my mouth. And the Lord said to me “Behold, I have put my words in your mouth.

Psalms 110:1 The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at **my right hand**, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

The Lord is calling his right hand Lord. Who is the right hand?

1 Peter 3:21-22 Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of **Jesus Christ**, who has gone into heaven and is at the **right hand of God**, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him.

Holy Spirit has a personality and not just a force (For JW):

[1 Corinthians 12 \(Spirit is a person\)](#) All these are empowered by one and the same **Spirit**, who apportions to each one individually as **he wills**.

[Ephesians 4:30 \(Holy Spirit grieves\)](#) “And do not **grieve** the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.”

[John 16:8](#) “And when he comes, he will **convict** the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment”

[Acts 5:3-4](#) “Then Peter said, “Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that **you have lied to the Holy Spirit** and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land? 4 Didn’t it belong to you before it was sold? And after it was sold, wasn’t the money at your disposal? What made you think of doing such a thing? **You have not lied just to human beings but to God.**”

All Three seen together:

[Matthew 28:19](#) “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in[a] the name of the **Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit**”

[Matthew 3:16-17](#) (They are three separate persons, but you can see them in one together in this scripture) “And when **Jesus** was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the **Spirit of God** descending like a dove and coming to rest on

him; and behold, **a voice from heaven** said, ‘This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.’”

2 Corinthians 13:14 “The grace of the **Lord Jesus Christ**, and the love of **God**, and the communion of the **Holy Spirit** be with you all. Amen.”

1 Peter 1:2 “according to the foreknowledge of **God the Father**, in the sanctification of the **Spirit**, for obedience to **Jesus Christ** and for sprinkling with his blood”

Genesis 1:2-3 “The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the **Spirit of God** was hovering over the face of the waters And **God said**, “Let there be light,” and there was light. (“God said” and we know the Word is Jesus)”

Summary: Jesus is God. The trinity refers to three persons, but one in the same essence/being. Example: we are all human beings, we are different persons. If you compare a man and a woman as a human being, we are equal; no one can be more human being than the other, but in rank and personality, biblically, man has a higher rank than women and we have different personalities. The same way the Holy Spirit, God, and Jesus are three persons in one essence with different rank/personalities.

Romans 10:9 “because, if you **confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord** and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, **you will be saved.**”
