
#### <u>Present Simple Tense (Part 1) - Theory</u>

VERB TO BE: ser, estar, tener (edad)

Verb CAN: poder

This verb should be always followed by another main verb in a sentence and it is used for all subject pronouns.

Grammar box



Yes, you do.

Does he / she / it like ...?

No, you don't.

## PRESENT SIMPLE

- Use the present simple to talk about *likes* and *habits*.
- All verbs are formed as like (affirmative, interrogative and negative forms). Add -s only for He / She / It in the affirmative forms. Leat breakfast.

He eats breakfast. I don't wear glasses. She doesn't wear glasses.

- In verbs ending in -s, -ch, -sh, -x and -o; add -es with He / She / It.
   My sister washes the dishes.
- Verbs ending in a consonant +y, drop the -y and add -ies He tidies his room.



- Use the present continuous to talk about actions that are happening now.
   I'm reading a comic.
   My aunt is living with us at the moment.
- We use adverbs of frequency with the present simple (always, usually, often, sometimes, never).
   My friends often go to the cinema.
- We use now, at the moment, these days with the present continuous.
   They're sleeping now.
