Staying Organized

Some 6th grade students really need help staying organized. If you know your child is someone who struggles with this, you can help in the following ways:

Take Home Folders	Binders
• Remove the graded returned work. • Remove the forms that you don't need. • Sign and return the forms you do need. • Look for "correct and return" on some math assignments. This allows students to earn a better score and get clear on concepts.	• Help them use the tabs in their binder to organize their papers by subject. • Designate an area in the binder that is used to keep unfinished assignments that are currently being worked on. • Remove any old papers that they don't need. • Designate an area for drawings if needed.

We know it can be painful to witness your child organize anything. It is a painstaking process for some. However, we want to build autonomy this year. We give lots of instruction and 1 on 1 support, but it takes at-home support as well to master this skill. Please help us to teach them to do it for themselves.
