SC 5TH ELECTION SCRIPT General June 20, 2018

*IF NO ANSWER AND THE NEXT CALL DOES NOT BEGIN AUTOMATICALLY:

Set Call Disposition to **No Answer**, then enter a note in the very last field, a dash "-" is sufficient.

Click Save and Next Call.

*IF CALL GOES TO VOICEMAIL - Set Call Disposition to Machine and leave message: Hi, this is a message for {Voter's name}. My name is {your name}, and I'm a volunteer with Democrats Abroad.

We're calling today to see if you have any questions about voting in the General Election in South Carolina's 5th Congressional District. Democrat Archie Parnell can win this District if we mobilize Democratic voters!

And there's still time to register to vote. Just go to **votefromabroad.org** and click **Start**. If you have any questions, we have an online chat desk at **votefromabroad.org** too. Don't delay - you must get your form in by **May 21** if you send it by **fax or email -** if you send it **by mail,** it needs to be **postmarked by May 22**. *IF THE VOTER ANSWERS THE PHONE:

Hi, this is {your name} from Democrats Abroad. May I speak to {voter name}? I'm calling to see if you have any questions about voting in the General Election in South Carolina to replace Mick Mulvaney in Congress. Democrat Archie Parnell can win this seat if Democrats come out to vote! Have you requested your ballot for this election - or have already received it?

You're not registered to vote (or not sure)?

No problem, you still have time and you use one form to register to vote *and* request a ballot for the election. Just go to **votefromabroad.org**, fill in the form, print it, sign and send it to your Local Election Official. The Instructions will provide the information you need to send in your form, but if you have any questions, the website has an online chat desk.

You are registered to vote but didn't vote in the Primary?

That's not a problem, you just need to request a ballot to vote in the General Election. Go to **votefromabroad.org**, fill in the form, print it, sign and send it to your Local Election Official. You can send it in by **email**, **fax or mail**. The Instructions will provide the information you need to send in your form, but if you have any questions, we have an online chat desk on the website. Or you can email us at: help@democratsabroad.org. [MARK SURVEY]

You voted in the Primary, but haven't received your ballot for the upcoming election? You don't have to worry yet as have until **June 20** to return your ballot, and you can send it back by **email or fax** too. But if you don't get it soon, check with your Local Election Official to make sure it's coming - also check your junk mail folder.
