- First days back
  - Return to school has been successful and teachers thoughtful care and planning as the kids kick off the year.
  - Beth has been meeting with the new families and working on open communication.
- Welcome back coffee:
  - well attended, happy to have all the K involvement.
- Building
  - The month of august really moved along. The topping off ceremony is going well. Very well and very noisy. Not too disruptive.
  - Traffic - police - she wants a police officer there and there will be community meetings with the 4th Tuesday of the month to share feedback.
    - Concerns about safety of the kids.
    - Blue zone is going well and people are using it the right way. Check out the website and community meetings.
- Work/ Greater School District:
  - Launching of the school year, the superintendent (NPS website) they went through the to find the portrait of a learner and they came up with different portrait - this will drive what we do as a community. The compass will be our bottom line and if you weren't around last year, they did it with 150 community members and they talked about what we want for our young people when they graduate.
  - This can also apply to use as a PTO. Dignity and belonging and that is a foundation of learning - this will lead to student engagement and achievement.
  - The goal is for the classroom to be rigorous and loving. Beth feels (we agree) that we have the best facility - on record.

Welcome - Steve, Tera and Melissa

They are there to help all families this coming year - thanks for coming

Few updates

- The school committee approved the budget - Steve and Rohit having the teacher stipend checks in hand
- Ward 5 out - will be leaving after the next election and at the school committee to review the equity policy and to maintain the spirit of the policy and make it less challenging for PTOs.
- Superintendent Nolan has worked to protect the PTO legally - there is no longer going to be a fun run. No bake sales and funding for the PTO during school hours.
- Equity item - it's a portion of the budget that specific items on and its equity items - you can put 40 (369 kids) there is 14 - 15k for equity items (teacher stipends, rugs, library books, field trip, and mini grants) this will be more scrutinized in the future to make sure that there is equity across each of the school.
  - 5th Grade bake sale - when kids are not in session, we can do that.
  - They did do it in the parent teacher conference and the big one is in the fall and that makes a big difference
- Universal Breakfast - They have a grab a go breakfast and there are bags available and the kids can go and say their name.
  - Sometimes if kids forgot a snack, they used that - Jillian (social worker) is working to find an alternative since we can no longer use breakfast food. ~30 kids a day
- Teacher representatives - they did not do teacher rep meetings last year, but teachers are happy to meet.
  - Meet 1x a month the morning of our meetings so we can bring items to the PTO meeting. This would allow the staff to weigh in on PTO items
  - Specific items -
    - Halloween party - too long (2.5 hours) - Historically - maybe the make the layover tighter
      - o 1.5 k- 2
      - o 1.5 3-5
      - o Do not want the kids going outside around the construction and kids get bored and wander the school

- Stipend checks - Thank you Rohit for sending those out so quickly this school year
- Room parents sign-ups - lots of activities there - teachers would like to have the formalized introduction to the room parents before the "Back to School" night
  - Erin Ray is going to provide an example of what was sent out
  - Beth H - having standardize would be great
- Erin - is the update going out bi- weekly, can the room parents send out a separate blast to get more people?
- Accessibility committee - they will let them know needs
  - Back to school - gluten free, dairy free options
  - Next meeting is the morning of October 8th

    - Good progress on the room parents - 15 out of the 19 classes
      - Do we want to coordinate on teacher/ parent expectations
