Denise Powell sets fundraising record in NE-02, raising \$430k in first quarter of campaign, solidifying front runner status

Powell campaign momentum continues to build following Bacon retirement announcement, race ratings changes

Omaha, Neb. – The Denise Powell for Congress campaign announced today that she raised over \$430,000 in her campaign's first quarter -- a record for any first time House candidate in Nebraska. More than 75 percent of her funds raised this quarter came from Nebraskans.

Powell's impressive fundraising haul builds on her early momentum, when the campaign raised a historic \$215,000 in just the first day of the race. Powell also launched with the support of a broad coalition of [local endorsements](#) from nearly 30 elected officials and organizations, demonstrating impressive grassroots and national support for her campaign.

"I am thrilled and humbled to receive such incredible and early support from Nebraskans and people across the country," Powell said. "It's clear that people are tired of lip service from politicians and ready for someone who is ready to go to Washington to put our communities first. This is our opportunity to send a champion for hardworking Nebraskans to Congress who will finally put a stop to the chaos of the Trump administration."

The fundraising announcement comes after a whirlwind of news in the district, including an announcement that Congressman Bacon will be retiring after this term and two race rating changes that moved NE-02 from Toss Up to Leans Democrat status from [Cook Political Report](#) and [Sabato's Crystal Ball](#).

Powell, who left a successful career in corporate America to fight for her community, has spent the past decade supporting local leaders, defending Nebraska's public schools, and fighting to block extreme abortion bans. Her campaign will center on bringing down costs for working families and protecting what makes Nebraska a great place to live and raise a family: strong public education, accessible healthcare, support for small businesses, and communities where everyone can thrive.

With deep ties to the district and a clear-eyed view of the challenges facing working families, Powell says Nebraskans are ready for leadership that reflects their values and fights for their future. *"This is a scary and uncertain time for our country and Nebraska families. But it's also a time to be brave – to stand up together, fight for one another, and demand better for our state."*
