

Music Business Transfer Plan



AA to BM in Music

- This is a plan that leads to a Bachelor of Music degree with a Music Business major option at WIU.
 Students will fill consult the advisors and catalogs from both schools for specifics. This completion guide is designed to promote graduation in four years by taking courses at both Waubonsee Community College (WCC) and Western Illinois University (WIU). This guide assumes students have met all course prerequisites required by WCC and admission requirements for WIU.
- Upon completion of the first two years' requirements at WCC, students will receive an Associate of Arts
 degree. Students will be required to complete the Music Business major option core requirements at WIU,
 and upon completion of the final two years' curriculum requirements students will receive the B.M. degree
 with a major in Music Business at WIU. In general, a minimum of 60 semester hours (s.h.) will be taken at
 WCC at WCC rates and 71 s.h. from WIU at WIU rates.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 should be achieved by the junior year. These grade point averages must be maintained for graduation as a Music Business major.

Notes for WCC

- 1. Transfer students will start at the Level 3 Theory/Aural Skills at WIU after taking Theory I and II at Waubonsee.
- 2. It is possible a student may start at the 400 level of applied lessons their first semester at WIU, but up to discretion of applied faculty at WIU. Transfer students may also delay audition for upper level lessons until end of 1st semester at WIU.
- 3. One course must have a non-Western or diversity emphasis. This is not an additional credit hour requirement. See Counseling for specific course requirements or recommendations.
- 4. Select one life science course and one physical science course. One course must have a lab.
- 5. Music Ensembles may be used to satisfy the Social Awareness/Personal Growth at Waubonsee.
- 6. Transfer students are recommended to take WIU Marketing 327 online the summer prior to third year in program. This will lock in tuition rates for the next year at WIU, count towards the B.M. at WIU and ease WIU student load
