4. Old Business

a. Street Signs replacement

Information included in the last newsletter. The HOA is currently in talks with the City of Powell on a project that would result in updating the street signs throughout our neighborhood. Our current street signs are approximately 20 years old and are not up to the latest safety standards designated by the state. The custom, decorative scroll pattern design is difficult to maintain as the signs age and need repairs. Fewer and fewer companies are interested in fixing or replacing custom signs like ours at a

reasonable cost. Right now, our HOA is responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of our street signs, since they are custom. The City of Powell has expressed interest in eventually having all street signs within city limits updated to a consistent design that is in line with the latest safety standards. Once updated, the city would take over responsibility and maintenance for street signs along city roads, which includes our neighborhood. The city signs are black with a simple and streamlined design.

The HOA is currently gathering quotes from sign companies to see what it would take to eventually replace our existing signs. We would consider a phased-in approach, and plan to talk more with the city regarding the best way to go about paying for the sign replacements.

Paul Petersen Company: Quoted just over \$15K for the whole project

Columbus Sign Co: Expressed interest, asked for more information, gave them more info from the city,

have not heard back on an estimate
