

Dual Credit Classes for SD Colleges – Juniors & Seniors

- Registration for the Spring semester is open on November 1st.
- Enrollment is limited to three courses (9 credits) per semester. First time students are limited to one (3 credits).
- Cost for tuition, books and supplies is student's responsibility. Tuition is \$48.33/credit
- It is required by the SD Board of Regents (SDBOR) that student's scores will be recorded on both their high school and college transcripts.

During the 2020 Legislative Session, changes were made to [SDCL § 13-28-37.1](#) with regard to continuing eligibility in the High School Dual Credit program. Starting with grades earned during the Fall 2020 Semester, any student who fails or withdraws from a HSDC course will no longer be eligible for the program in future semesters, absent a showing of good cause. Students who earn a F or W grade and who wish to continue in the program must meet one of the three options listed on the following link:

recommend students only take Dual Credit classes if they are prepared to work at the collegiate level and have their academic goal set for an A or B. Students do not want to begin their college career with anything less than a 3.0 college GPA.

Eligibility Requirements

(1) **High school junior** eligible to enroll in a high school in South Dakota who meets one of the following requirements:

- a) earn an ACT composite score of 24 reflective of the 70% percentile; or
- b) rank in upper one-third of their graduating class; or
- c) earn a cumulative GPA of at least 3.50 on a 4.0 scale;

(2) **High school senior** eligible to enroll in a high school in South Dakota who meets one of the following requirements:

- a) earn an ACT composite score of 21 reflective of the 50% percentile; or
- b) rank in the upper one-half of their graduating class; or
- c) earn a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 on a 4.0 scale;

A. Begin Registration

All students must meet with the high school counselor to confirm eligibility and course selection.

1. After meeting with Mr. Breske – each student must complete the High School Dual Credit (HSDC) application online at:

2. Click **APPLY ONLINE**
3. Read carefully and choose **Method #1 or Method #2**
4. Complete and print the form (Or electronically sign)
5. This form must be signed by a parent and the student as well as the DC Agreement Form

6. **Turn the form in to Mr. Breske for the counselor's signature – Deadline: December 16th – NO EXCEPTIONS**
7. Mr. Breske will send the form with the student's transcript to the campus contact

B. Students Complete Registration

1. Check the email address you used for application frequently! – you will receive a confirmation email.
2. Confirmation email has steps required to **complete the registration process**. This includes information for ordering books, setting up university email, D2L, WebAdvisor and more.
Tip: Do not wait to order books – you will want your books in hand for the first day of semester!
3. Payment information is included in the confirmation email.
