- The Linear Regression Model: Foundations and Functional Form (Simple and multiple regression, hypothesis testing, introduction to nonlinearities via logs and polynomials)
- Model Specification, Interpretation, and Joint Hypothesis Testing (Interactions, categorical variables, model comparison, and testing groups of regressors.)
- Regression Diagnostics and Inference with Non-Ideal Data (Multicollinearity, outliers, heteroskedasticity, autocorrelation, and robust solutions.)
- Introduction to Nonlinear Regression Models (Maximum Likelihood Estimation, Binary Response Models (Logit/Probit))
- Addressing Confounding: Matching and Propensity Score Methods (The selection problem, matching on observables, propensity score estimation, and the Conditional Independence Assumption)
- Instrumental Variables and Experiments (Causality with unobserved confounders, the IV solution, 2SLS)
- Panel Data and Fixed Effects Regression
