

Curriculum Review Committee Meeting Minutes

Location: Elizabeth High School

1. AI Policy Discussion

The committee discussed the development of an upcoming Artificial Intelligence (AI) policy. Several sample policies were reviewed to guide the conversation. Key points of discussion included:

- The importance of establishing clear expectations for both staff and students
- Defining appropriate use, including when and where AI tools should be utilized
- Ensuring the policy reflects responsible and ethical use of AI in an educational setting

Next Steps (AI Policy):

- A subcommittee will be formed to continue development of the AI policy over the summer

2. Math Curriculum Resources Review

The committee reviewed two potential new high school math textbook resources:

- McGraw Hill *Reveal Math*
- Savvas Learning *enVision Math*

After examining both resources, the committee noted:

- Both options represent an improvement over current materials
- The resources are similarly aligned in terms of standards and pacing
- Each would effectively support the needs of students and families

The committee agreed that either resource would be a strong option moving forward.

Next Steps (Math Resource):

- The committee is awaiting the arrival of one or possibly two additional math resources for review
- Once all materials are available, a public viewing will be scheduled at the high school
- Students, parents, and the Board Curriculum Review Committee (BCRC) will be invited to review and provide feedback
