PBIS: We have our RAMS WAY store up and running! Students are responding positively to this. Our focus area this month is entering the classroom appropriately.






## **Walkthrough Focus:**





The SAM process uses a data collection process to determine how much time principals are spending on instructional, management, and personal time.
