



Session 6 - Badly Behaving Men (Cain - Gen. 4, Jacob - Gen. 27, Judah - Gen. 38)

Examples of badly behaving men in Genesis:

CAIN - ANGER AND IDOLATRY (GEN. 4)

JACOB - DISHONESTY AND DECEPTION (GEN. 25:29-34, 27:18-25)

JUDAH - SEXUAL PERVERSION AND MISOGYNY (GEN. 38)

An example of the difference a redeemed man can make: JOSEPH (GEN 50:20).

- It's not easy to admit who you are, but of Cain, Jacob, and Judah who do you see yourself most like when you are not living for the Lord?
- How do you see manhood in our culture influence by:

 - The spirit of Judah - sexual perversion and misogyny?
- How do we see the glory of God in each of these sordid stories? What does it say about our God that he gives grace and has a redemptive plan even for badly behaving men?
