

# WENATCHEE AIRGUN MATCH

## FRIDAY MAY 6, 2022

**SPONSORED BY:** Washington State Rifle & Pistol Association.

**LOCATION:** The North Central Washington Gun Club  
2740 Gun Club Road  
East Wenatchee, Washington 98802

The range is located in the basement of the large clubhouse on the range grounds.

The North Central Washington gun club requires eye and ear protection be used.

**NOTE:**

We will be allowing Smallbore practice at the 50 to 100-yard range in the afternoon.

**RULES:**

Current CMP 3PAR Air Rifle Rules will be used for this match and finals, with the exception of time limits. The Orion Air Rifle targets will be used.

**CLASSIFICATION:**

Competitors will use their current WSR&PA junior smallbore classification for this match.

**COURSE OF FIRE:**

40 shots, standing, 33 feet (10 meters). 25 minutes will be allowed for two 10 bull target. Two targets will be hung at a time. Competitors will hang their targets.

**SQUADDING:**

There will be three relays: #1 – 3:30 PM, #2 – 5:00 PM, #3 – 6:30 PM. Finals at 8:00 PM  
Squadding assignments will be issued Friday evening.

**SCORING & CHALLENGES:**

Decimal scoring will be used. Targets will be scored in the stat office. There will be no challenges, since we are using decimal scoring. However, competitors along with the Stats office can review shots for Obvious Errors as defined by Orion Scoring System and make the necessary adjustment.

**ENTRY:**

Advance entry is requested, relays fill up. Post entries will be accepted to range capacity. There are 14 firing points per relay, match capacity is 42 shooters.
