The Story of Digestion Flow Chart

Answer Key

The mouth is the starting point where the food is ground by the teeth and chemicals in saliva start the digestion process.



The food is swallowed and goes down the long muscular tube called the esophagus.



The food goes into the stomach which is very muscular and acid "rains down" on the food.



The small intestine is next where chemicals from the liver and pancreas break down the leftovers. The villi in the small intestine absorb tremendous amounts of nutrients.



The large intestine is where the leftovers that your body cannot use go and water is removed from them.



The anus is where the remaining leftovers that your body cannot use are expelled.
