<p>Entries</p>	<p>Club coaches or representatives, please complete your entries directly to the Crewtimer sheet that will be distributed on July 4th and OPEN FOR ENTRIES till July 9th.</p> <p>A draft draw will be sent out by Tuesday morning of July 23rd at the very latest. Coaches will be able to make scratches and substitutions directly to the document until Wednesday, July 24, 6.00pm. Additional entries will be allowed only if space permits.</p> <p>A final draw will be available on Thursday, July 25, around 12pm.</p>

Neither of those require qualification during the Provincial Championship. 	<p>Volunteers and officials will meet 45 minutes prior to the start of the races each morning. Coaches will be asked to check in sometime prior to the start of races for a 5 minute briefing.</p>
<p>Rules</p> <p>Categories</p>	<p>CanoeKayak Canada's Sprint Racing Discipline Competition 2024 Rules ("Rulebook") will be used.</p> <p>U10: Born in the year 2014 or later U12: Born in the year 2012 U14: Born in the year 2010</p> <p>Masters: Athletes that are 25+ (see note above about age restrictions for Canadian National Championships and CanMas)</p> <p>Paracanoe: Athletes meeting ICF Paracanoe requirement</p>

Technical	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clubs are expected to bring their own deck numbers. • U16 and younger athletes MUST wear PFDs approved under the small vessels regulations within Canada's Shipping Act • 5 minutes to start may not be called for every race. 3 and 1 minute will be called • CKBC scale will be used for weight boat control for singles and doubles for U14 and older categories
Trailers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trailer parking will be communicated closer to the regatta date
Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equipment Security will be provided on Friday and Saturday evenings.
Miscellaneous Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No athletes will be allowed on water until 45 min prior to the first race start time • Coaches are asked to check in with the Event Manager (Stan Marek) upon arrival to the site • WAR CANOE races MIGHT be included as a demonstration disciplines, the exact format will be discussed with coaches and communicated back to the clubs • We are planning to have designated practice time on Friday evening for those who wish to paddle AND weight the boat - the scale will be available on Friday evening and Saturday morning prior to the first race - details will be released and communicated closer to the regatta dates • There shall be NO TENTS placed at the parking lot - all tents and athletes shall be located up at the grandstands. Only trailers and boats will be located in the front part of the parking lot • Please all clubs and athletes be aware this event will serve as a Canada Summer Games 2025 Long List selection trial. More information will be provided by a separate document
