As we transition into the new school year, our focus is Social Emotional Learning with daily check-ins and activities. We also held a building-wide assembly to share Howard's expectations/norms with all our students, addressing bullying prevention! Please review the Howard PBIS Matrix to help support us at home with reviewing appropriate and expected school behavior. Please support us by speaking to your child about the importance of always keeping their hands to themselves, as this falls under the three main Howard Habits of being RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE, AND SAFE. Please remember to contact your child's teacher if you have any questions or concerns. Open communication is vital! We appreciate your teamwork in advance.

We are also excited to continue implementing the initiatives we began a couple of years ago, including weekly STEAM enrichment for all students in grades K-5 and student spotlight. Student Spotlight gives EVERY student at Howard a chance to be celebrated and appreciated. Furthermore, during the weekly student spotlight, each student will have an opportunity to share authentic information about who they are; this includes culture and family backgrounds (a poster template will come home



when it is your child's turn). We encourage parents/guardians to work on this template with students when it is their turn to shine! :-)

Finally, please note that the i-Ready assessment is completed; Howard is pleased to continue to provide the "My Path" program as an additional resource through the i-Ready program to all students. I-Ready My Path instruction offers online lessons that motivate students on their paths to proficiency and growth. Each student's personalized pathway in math and reading is based on their performance on the i-Ready Diagnostic to meet students where they are in their personalized learning journey. Please support us at home by ensuring your child logs into i-Ready weekly to reach their maximum potential. Your child's teacher will share more information regarding this.

### Traffic/Safety
