- 4. This volunteer experience requires data entry into the <u>iNaturalist App</u> <u>having your own</u>, <u>fully functional and charged smartphone that can access this App is required for this event</u>.
- 5. We will go on a hike of the area to collect data. Please come prepared to be walking the trails outdoors.
- 6. Bring a water bottle with you because hydration is key and there is NO potable water on site. Please note **WASHROOMS** are available on-site.
