1. Example Sentences - 2 possible structures

- **(When) I got home**, it started to rain.
- It started to rain **when I got home.**

When **the car was repaired**, I took a nap.

- **While** I was cooking, my phone **rang.**
- **Before** you leave, please check your email.

- **As soon as** I finished the call, I sent the report.
- **After** I graduated, I moved to another city.
- **As** I walked down the street, I saw my old teacher.
- Until you try it, you won't know if you like it.
- Since I met you, my English has improved a lot.
- Because it was late, we decided to take a taxi.
- **Although** I was tired, I finished the project.
- I finished the project although I was tired.

- **Even though++** it was expensive, we bought it.

- **Though** the weather was bad, we went hiking. (formal)
- We went hiking **though** the weather was bad. (formal)

Common in speaking

- We went hiking... the weather was bad **though**.
 - We went hiking, **but** the weather was bad **though**.
 - It's sunny, but it's cold **though**.
-
- If it rains tomorrow, we'll stay home.
 - **Once/When/After** you understand the rule, it becomes easy.

Since - 2 meanings

1. (from a time in the past until now)

Since I moved to Vancouver, my skin has gotten so dry.

> I have lived in Vancouver **since July**.

> I have loved soccer **since I went to my first game in 2011.**

> I have had lots of hair **since I was born.**

2. (**because**)

> Since I missed the bus, I was late to class.

Because I missed the bus, I was late to class.

> I am learning English **since/as/because** I want to be a pilot.

As

1. Because - I am learning English **since/as/because** I want to be a pilot.

2. As/While - As I was driving**ing** to work, I was listening to a podcast in English. (at the same time)
