

CHARITY PROGRAM OF CHARITY ORGANIZATION "CHARITY FUND "IRON SHIELD OF UKRAINE" for 2023

Dnipro

January 1, 2023

The charity program is a set of charitable activities in the areas defined by the Law of Ukraine "On Charitable Activities and Charitable Organizations" dated 07/05/2012.

The charity program was developed by the CHARITY ORGANIZATION "CHARITY FOUNDATION "IRON SHIELD OF UKRAINE" (hereinafter the Foundation) in accordance with the Charter of the Foundation; by the Law of Ukraine "On Charitable Activities and Charitable Organizations" dated 07/05/2012; other normative legal acts of Ukraine.

Validity of the Charity Program: January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

The purpose of the Charity Program: to organize and implement charity events aimed at:

- promotion of defense capability and mobilization readiness of the country, protection of the population in emergency situations of peace and war;
- implementation of charitable activities in the interests of society, to improve the defense capability of the Armed Forces;
- assistance to the families of servicemen who died as a result of anti-terrorist or other military operations;
- assistance to military personnel injured during anti-terrorist or other military operations;
- implementation and comprehensive support of the implementation of assistance programs for military personnel;

Geography of the Charity Program: the territory of Ukraine.

Means of implementation of the Charity Program: for the implementation of the Charity Program, the Foundation has developed the following main direction - assistance to servicemen who were injured during anti-terrorist or other military operations.

The purpose of the "Support a soldier of Ukraine" program: Assistance for treatment, rehabilitation and restoration of the psychological/emotional state, reintegration into society of servicemen who were injured.

Participants of the "Support a soldier of Ukraine" program: servicemen who were injured during anti-terrorist or other military operations, namely: of any age, of any gender, of any severity of injury, with a place of registration in any region of Ukraine , and those who were wounded in any place of hostilities.

The following actions are possible within the framework of the "Support a Soldier of Ukraine" Program:

- payment of financial aid to the bank account of the program participant;
- purchase of medicines and payment for medical operations/procedures, rehabilitation measures, according to an official medical diagnosis, or other medical documents;
- holding events, psychologist consultations, self-help groups, etc., aimed at restoring the psychological/emotional state of program participants, and reintegration into society.

Sources of funding for the "Support a Soldier of Ukraine" Program:

The Fund may own movable and immovable property, tangible and intangible assets, funds, as well as other property acquired on legal grounds and necessary for the implementation of the Foundation's statutory activities.

The sources of the Fund's assets and funds are:

- the property transferred to him by the founders, in particular, the introductory, membership and voluntary contributions of the founders and members of the Fund in cash and in kind;
- donations from benefactors and charitable contributions;
- charitable contributions of a targeted nature (charitable grants) provided by individuals and legal entities in monetary and in-kind form;
- proceeds from conducting charitable campaigns for collecting charitable donations, charitable mass events, charitable lotteries and charitable auctions for the sale of property received from benefactors;
- income from deposit and securities;
- property and funds acquired as a result of economic and other commercial activities of enterprises founded by the fund, created by self-supporting institutions and organizations;
- property acquired at the expense of own funds or on other grounds not prohibited by law;
- other sources not prohibited by the current legislation of Ukraine.

Implementation and implementation of the Charity Program, reporting

The Director of the Foundation is responsible for coordinating and organizing the implementation and implementation of the Charity Program.

The charity program is carried out by the Fund Participant (if desired), the Director of the Fund, full-time employees (if available). Also, other persons who are not participants or full-time employees of the Foundation, as well as volunteers, may be involved in the execution of the Charity Program, by the decision of the Director.

The decision to provide charitable assistance to the Foundation for the implementation and implementation of the Charity Program is made by the Director of the Foundation.

At the written request of a benefactor who made a charitable contribution to the implementation of the Charity Program, the Director provides the applicant with a report on the intentions or facts of the expenditure of funds received on his behalf.

Annually (within a month after the expiration of the Program), the Director prepares a report on the results of the Charity Program implementation. The report to the Director on the results of the implementation of the Charity Program must contain information on:

- fulfilling the purpose of the Charity Program;
- implemented measures to achieve the goal of the Charity Program;
- the amount of funds collected and allocated for the implementation of the Charity Program;

The participant's decision approves the Director's report on the implementation of the Charity Program.

The Fund also prepares and submits financial, statistical and other mandatory reporting in accordance with the procedure established by law in accordance with Article 17 of the Law of Ukraine "On Charitable Activities and Charitable Organizations" dated 07/05/2012.
