

Among the many challenging things about any seder is choosing which haggadah (or multiple haggadot) to use. We have compiled this list of links to Haggadot available online, with brief descriptions of each one. This list is definitely not exhaustive--there are dozens of haggadot of all shapes, sizes, flavors, and Jewish denominations--but these are the ones that we found to be user-friendly, printable, and/or interesting. We have also included links to some seder tunes to help you prepare and/or get in the mood.

Full Traditional Haggadahs with Hebrew and English translation

 - Instructions in English, gendered masculine (i.e. assumes the person leading the seder is a man)
 - Includes commentary in English

 - Instructions in English
 - Introduction in English and also a Pesach message (in English) from the Rebbe!

 - Online it is very customizable: you can see English, Hebrew, or both, and you can see dozens of commentaries on each paragraph, most of which are available in both Hebrew and English

 - I find the site very difficult to use and I can't figure out a way to print something remotely usable, but you may have better luck! In any case, might be a useful resource in preparing for the seder.

 - Includes the basic brachot (4 cups of wine, shehechyanu, hamotzi, matzah, bitter herb) in Hebrew, English, and transliteration
