Curriculum & Instruction Update	• We will be winding up our Friday Tutoring Program for our students who are struggling in ELA and/or Math in May. We currently have teachers who are tutoring students in small groups, for a half-day per group. There are 60 students signed up for this program. Teachers are very happy with the gains they are already seeing. • We administered the MSSA (New Mexico Measures of Student Success and Achievement). Grades 3-5 have been testing in the iMSSA, a new assessment required by the NMPED three times per year- at the beginning, middle and end of the school year. The End of Year MSSA test was given in late April. Results should come in over the summer. • Our K-2 teachers had their last LETRS training for the year on May 11, 2022. LETRS (Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling) training is a scientifically-based, structured literacy training that will help them with their English language arts instruction. Our third grade teachers will start training next year in LETRS. • MC squared (math) training has wrapped up for the school year, both on Teacher Training days and through MC squared trainer, Megan Kidwell, who comes to our school to coach teachers on math instruction and meets with them during their Professional Learning Community (PLCs) Meetings. She even works in the classrooms with our teachers and students. This program incorporates hands-on learning to help students understand math on a conceptual level. Mathematically Connected Communities (MC²) is a partnership of dedicated math educators including teachers, university mathematicians, school/district administrators, and researchers working collaboratively to improve mathematics learning for K-12 students across the state of New Mexico.

See Pictures Below • We had our ninth, virtual Parent Advisory Council (PAC) meeting on Wednesday, May 11, 2022. We discussed having our Daddy/Daughter Dance- and the revenue and expenditures of PAC over the course of the school year. Ms. Grigg will be sending out a survey to see if more parents would like to get involved in PAC. • SEMA (Socorro Educational Mentoring Alliance) finished up at Parkview. Mentors from NMTECH have provided after-school homework help as well as mentoring, for students in grade 3 and 4, for four days per week this school year. They ended the year with a trip to EXPLORA, a science museum in Albuquerque. • We are pleased to continue to take part in the Foster Grandparents Program through the County of Socorro. We have two “Grandmas” who come to assist on our campus. Grandma Rosemary is in Ms. Chavez’s third grade and Grandma Rosie in Ms. Wills’ kindergarten. These ladies are cherished by our students and staff alike. • Since our principal is a member of the Equity Council, she takes part in the Socorro Consolidated School District’s Equity Council Meeting. • Every 6 weeks, El Defensor Chieftain publishes a page about Parkview containing information about our staff and students and events at the school.
Celebrations	• From May 2 through May 5, we celebrated “Teacher Appreciation Week” with the following treats for our teachers: On Mon., our teachers had 10-min. chair massages, on Tues., our teachers and staff had donuts, on Wed., our teachers had “Room Service” (see a picture of the Room Service Slip below), and on Thursday, our teachers had breakfast burritos from Sofia’s. so it doesn't float up either



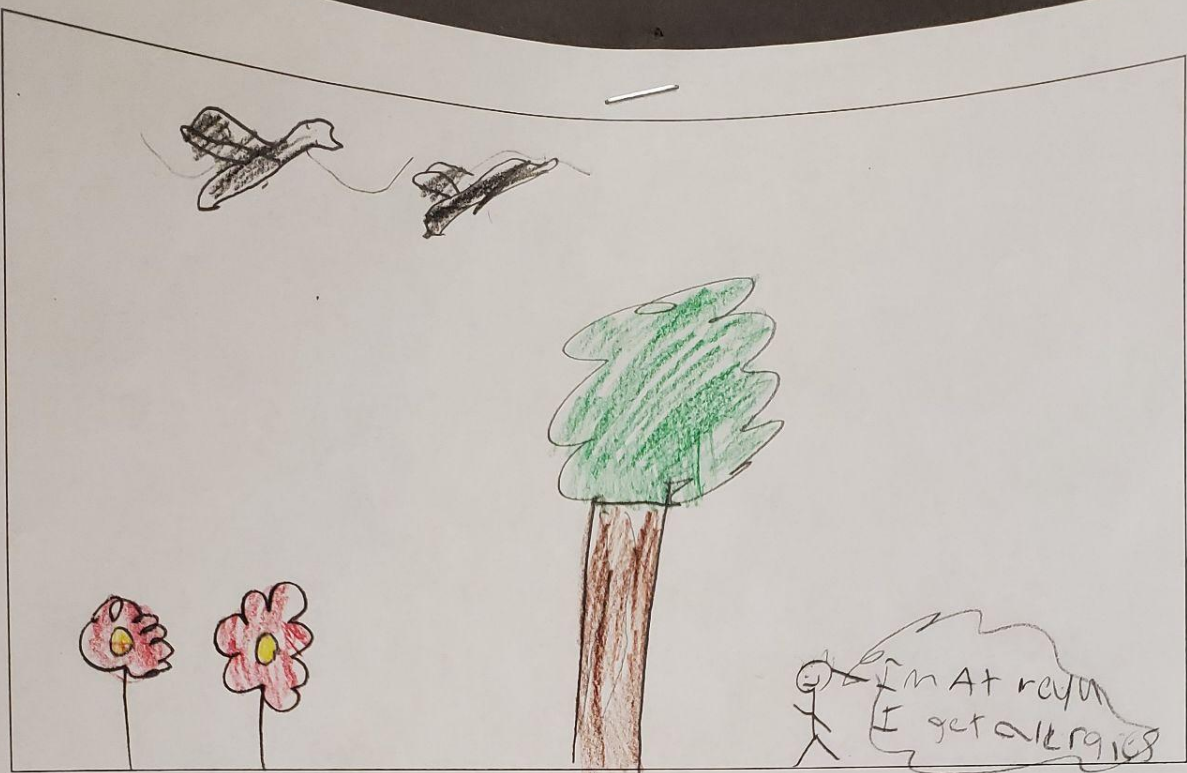

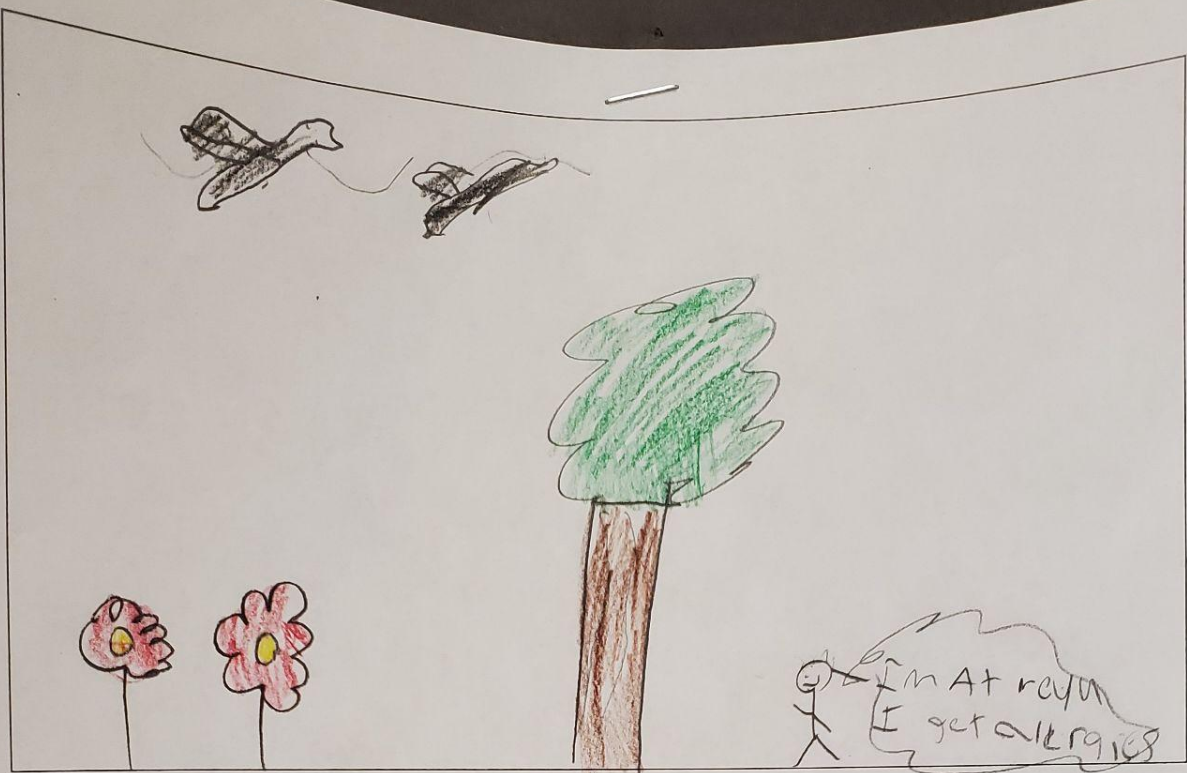
