

BREAKFAST/LUNCH Grades 9-12 and new Students 2024/2025

Breakfast Daily Cost for Grades 9-12 \$1.40 Reduced Pricing \$.20

The School District of Shiocton offers variety of breakfast items to choose from. The breakfast program has two reimbursable breakfast options. Cereal, yogurt, muffins, french toast sticks, etc. are examples of items offered. A monthly menu is posted in The Link, on the school website, and posted in the cafeteria. Due to the Smart Snack in Schools regulation Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, Four food items are offered daily. When purchasing a reimbursable breakfast, three out of the four items must be taken. A full serving (1 cup) of fruit is offered daily, ½ cup fruit must be on the student's tray prior to purchasing.

A la carte items and pricing will be available at the start of 2023-24 school year.

Lunch Daily Costs for Grades 9-12 \$2.95 Reduced Prices \$.30

Shiocton School District has an "Offer vs Serve" system. Five components will be offered each day. These five components are protein, vegetable, fruit, whole grain breads, and milk. Your student will need to take three of the five items offered. Due to the Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, when purchasing a reimbursable lunch a full serving (1 cup) of fruit and (1 cup) of vegetables will be offered, ½ cup serving must be on the student's tray prior to purchasing a meal. The School District of Shiocton encourages your child(ren) to take all five of the food components for a healthier, more nutritious lunch.

An ala carte form must be signed by the parent/guardian. This form is for single a la carte items only. The form will be available during online registration and can also be found on our website. If the form is not signed, the ala carte form from the prior year will be used or purchases will not be allowed. Please submit at registration or prior to the first day of school to Heather Knops Foodservice Director.

Please keep in mind parents/guardians and students are responsible to know his/her limits. If a student takes an item the item will be paid for.

Milk

One milk is included with each meal, if an extra milk is purchased the cost is \$.40.

Just a reminder, if your child(ren) receives free meals and they choose to bring a cold lunch, money needs to be in the account prior to purchasing milk or the students can pay in cash.

Free/Reduced Program

Free/Reduced applications will be mailed to each family household after July 1, 2024. Please fill out the application form, return at registration, school offices before the start of the school year,

or Heather Knops Foodservice Director. If at any time during the school year your financial situation changes, ie: loss of employment, an application can be submitted at that time. All information on the application must be accurate or the form will be returned to you, which will delay your qualification for the free and /or reduced program. Reduced pricing is set by DPI.

Keypad numbers

Students are assigned a four digit number. These numbers are connected to the student's food service accounts. Students should know their numbers and keep them confidential. The four digit number belongs to your student until they graduate and does not change.

When your account reaches \$10.00 or below

The School District of Shiocton SkyAlert automated calling system will call, email, and/or text the primary person on the family account to inform you of your balance. You will receive a call on Mondays and Thursdays when balances are \$10.00 or below. Just like a checking account, the account must remain above zero (in the positive). You will receive a call on Tuesdays and Fridays when the balances are in the negative. If your balance falls below \$-30.00, you will be mailed a reminder and/or a letter stating that your child/children are unable to purchase a meal or ala carte until the balance is paid and has a positive balance. Families are able to make payments by check or cash, which can be dropped off at the High School Office or given to Heather Knops Foodservice Director. We encourage the use of the Skyward Family Access e-funds for schools program for electronic payments. Information on how to pay online will be provided during registration or go to our website www.shiocton.k12.wi.us for instructions. Please keep your phone numbers, address and emails current. The breakfast/lunch program at Shiocton Schools is a family account program. The student(s) are able to purchase a meal or ala carte items from one account with separate keypad numbers for each student. Money needs to be deposited into your family account prior to purchases being made. Only one check is needed for all family members. The Menu will be posted on the schools website, link and in the cafeteria
