RE: Safety quidelines for after-school athletic and extracurricular activities

Hello,

I'd like to remind all patrons attending events on campus, and/or utilizing District facilities of the rules and guidelines developed to promote the safety of our students, parents, staff, and fans.

We ask that all who attend events to please treat our facilities with respect while adhering to the following guidelines:

- No alcoholic beverages
- No tobacco/smoking or vaping
- No open containers, coolers, cans or bottles
- No lasers
- No fireworks
- No noisemakers: horns, bells, whistles, etc.
- No weapons, including guns, knives, etc. (This includes concealed carried weapons)
- No items that the school may interpret as hazardous
- Any prohibited item found on school grounds will be confiscated
- Photo ID may be required
- No one is permitted on track during school activities
- Only food purchased from the concession stand will be permitted
- No pets are permitted on the grounds
- Organized athletic groups must have prior School Board approval for use of grounds
- No motorized or wheeled vehicles on any athletic field/track, etc.
- No bikes, roller skates/blades, scooters or skateboards
- Do not place any tape or markings on the turf/track/gym floors
- Please utilize garbage cans for trash
- Please do not move any equipment on turf or track (nets, track equipment, etc.)
- Only athletic shoes are permitted on turf field and track
- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- No Drones.
- No motor vehicles are to be driven on the track, on any grass areas and/or in the stadium
- No bags of any size will be permitted in the stadium or gymnasiums.
- Students in grades K-8 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Exiting fans will not be permitted re-entry
- Entry after half time will only be permitted for athletes' parents/guardians with a district issued game pass.

Additionally, all patrons will be required to enter facilities by passing through metal detectors.

**Beginning immediately– Fans attending indoor sports at the Jr/Sr. Highschool are required to enter DOOR 14. This door is the first entrance on the stadium side of the building.
