Venue

Format

Presenters are allotted 35 minutes. A 5-10 minute overview is suggested, allowing 25-30 minutes for discussion. Moderators will facilitate discussion and keep track of time.

Etiquette

We ask all participants to follow these rules of virtual etiquette:

- Presenters: Please keep your video on as much as possible during your presentation and discussion.
- Audience: Mute your audio unless asking a question or commenting. To ask questions during discussion, please use the “raise hand” feature or type your question into the chat. Please wait to submit questions or comments in the chat until after the presenter has completed their initial overview of the paper.
- Please be mindful of time when asking questions or providing comments.
- Please be courteous to presenters and participants.
- Please do not interrupt presenters or participants.
