 - (1) Executive Director Mark Brown reported that the 2 biggest fires, the Dixie and the Caldor fires are basically under control. California still faces at least 1 to 3 months of wildland fire season.
 - c) Zonehaven
 - (1) software program that produces digital evacuation maps for residents escaping disasters, specifically wildfires
 - (2) Publicity campaign begun to inform Marin County residents
 - d) Stinson Beach still hasn't had any defensible space inspections this year but should soon
 - e) West Marin Zone Evacuation Core Project:
 - (1) Purpose is to improve routes for evacuation and egress/ingress throughout the community
 - (2) Creating safe evacuation routes is important to long term fire adapting strategies
 - (3) Stinson Beach
 - (a) Core project submitted was large evacuation route, calle del arroyo and working on lower willow camp on the project
 - (b) Overall core project majority of work won't be done in Bolinas / Stinson since most funding went to the frontloader at bolinas recovery site
 - (4) Front Loader
 - (a) Arriving in next couple weeks
 - (b) Residents can get 50% off at site, need letter written by district
