

Spotlight on Nature

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Spotlight of Nature; (163579)
- **Paper:** Pretty in Pink C/S (163793); Basic White (159276);
- **Stamp Pads:** Pebbled Path (161648); Pretty In Pink (163807)
- **Tools:** Spotlight on Nature (163480):
- **Miscellaneous:** Soft Sea Foam Blends (154902); Pretty in Pink Blends (1638234); Wink of Stella (141897); Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220); Pretty in Pink 3/8" Bordered Ribbon (163784); Distressed Tile 3D (162189); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Multipurpose Glue (110755);



Measurements:

- Pretty in Pink : 8 1/2" x 5 1/2", 4"x4",
- Basic White : 4 x 5 1/4", scrap pieces for sentiment and Butterfly

Instructions:

1. Fold cardstock base in half on score line. And burnish.
2. Stamp the Flower image onto the 4"X 5 1/4" piece of Basic White using the Pebbled Path.
3. Stamp the Butterfly onto scrap piece of Basic White also using the Pebbled Path.
4. Colour the Flower and Butterfly images using the Pretty in Pink Blends and leaves with Soft Sea Foam Blends. As shown in photo.
5. Cut out the Flower image out using the third largest circle from the Spotted in Nature Dies.
6. With the 4"x 4" Pretty in Pink and the second largest die cut out using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine
7. Emboss the Flower stamped images using the Distressed Tile 3D D Adhere with the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
8. Adhere the smaller flower stamped image onto the Pretty in Pink die cut piece using dimensionals.
9. Wrap the Pretty in Pink ribbon on the bottom end of the embossed piece of Basic White and adhere to card base using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

10. Adhere the Pretty in Pink and Flower piece onto card. Be sure to line up the flower images.
11. Fussy cut the Butterfly and adhere to the card front. Add some bling by colouring the Butterfly with Wink of Stella.
12. Stamp sentiment with Pretty in Pink onto a scrap of Basic White. Trim down the edges and add to card front.
13. Finish the card by adding Rhinestones. .
