

Grade Recovery Plan

You have the opportunity to recover ONE summative grade per Standards Category.

All assignments are due at the beginning of class on Friday, December 12. NO EXCEPTIONS. If the activity must be done during a class period, you are required to complete it on the day your teacher designates. These dates will be announced in advance.

- Options for Recovering a **Language** grade CHOOSE ONE
 - Vocabulary: Write a paragraph describing each of the photographs on your handout. (This will be available as a .pdf on your teacher's blog.) **YOU MUST USE 16 WORDS FROM UNIT 14.**
 - Grammar: Complete the packet on easily-confused words and punctuation. You will need to ask your teacher for a copy.
- Options for Recovering a **Reading** grade CHOOSE ONE
 - Take a test over *The Panchatantra*. You'll receive a copy of the story, which you'll read and then answer questions over it. This must be completed during December 11th. If you are unprepared or absent on that day, you forfeit the privilege.
 - Create a game that students can use for review for one of the units. Use index cards, questions on one side, answers on the other. 20 questions. [You can find printable game boards here.](#)
- Options for Recovering a **Writing** grade CHOOSE ONE
 - Choose one of the questions on the list for the *Oedipus the King* Socratic seminar. Write an argumentative essay of 250-500 words in which you answer the question using evidence from the text (including at least two direct quotes.)
 - Do the same thing with one of the prompts for *The Alchemist* Socratic seminar. See your teacher for the list of questions.
- Options for Recovering a **Speaking and Listening** grade
 - Choose a prompt from the *Oedipus* Socratic seminar list. (If you did the argumentative essay above, then you must choose a different prompt.) Prepare a speech in which you give your educated opinions about the prompt, backing up your opinions with evidence. You will present your speech to the entire class on December 11th. If you are absent or ill-prepared, you forfeit your opportunity to present.

By completing these assignments satisfactorily you will prove that you have met the standard in that grade category and will have the ability to replace ONE summative grade in that category with an 80. You **MUST** tell Mrs. Bundschu which grade you are replacing so that she can correctly adjust the grade book.
