AESTHETICS IN THE DIALOGUE OF CULTURES

Aesthetic regime of dialogue: re-thinking Mikhail Bakhtin's heritage and the global influence of his ideas.

Intersubjective and intercultural meanings of expressive forms: homage to Alexey Losev in the year of his 130th anniversary.

Different languages, common emotions: Roman Jakobson's basic ideas on the origin of languages and their role in intercultural dialogue.

Colours and their meaning in emotional exchange of cultures: back to Wassily Kandinsky's theory of chromatic experience.

Participation

For international speakers OIAC XI will be held *online*, with *full publication* of papers in *English* and *Russian*.

We kindly ask you to send us your paper with your full name, the name of your academic position, the title of your presentation, abstract, key words, references after the main text, Book Antiqua, 12, interval 1. Your English text must have full Russian translation with the same parameters. The *total volume* of the two versions must be *no more than 15 pages*.

Please, before the name paste the number and the theme of the panel discussion you have chosen.

The *deadline* for papers is *May, 1, 2023*.

We'll answer on *acceptation* to *May, 20, 2023*.

The *Book of OIAC XI Proceedings* will be published until *November, 20, 2023* as the special issue of *Aesthetica Universalis* theoretical quarterly
