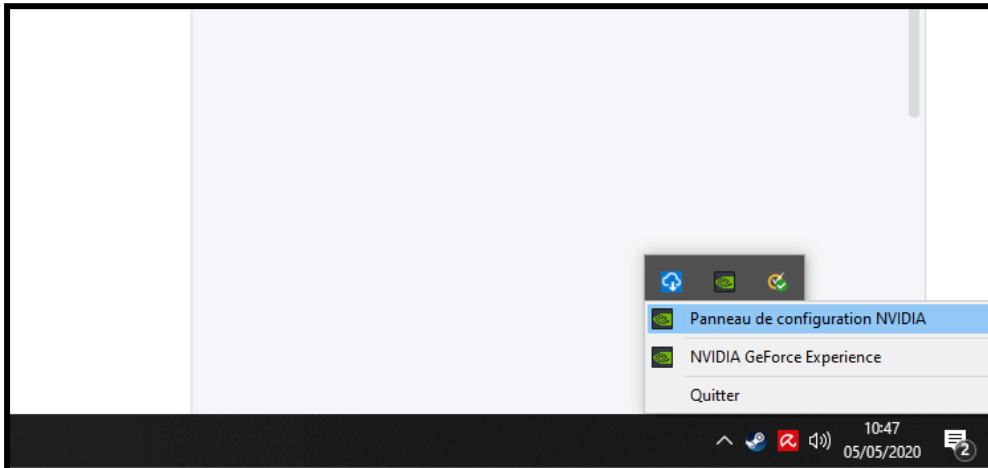


First of all, my computer is set in French. I will translate what's on the screenshots to English throughout the document for a better global comprehension.

In order to deactivate vertical sync, you have to go to the **NVIDIA Control Panel**.

- **Accessing Nvidia control panel**

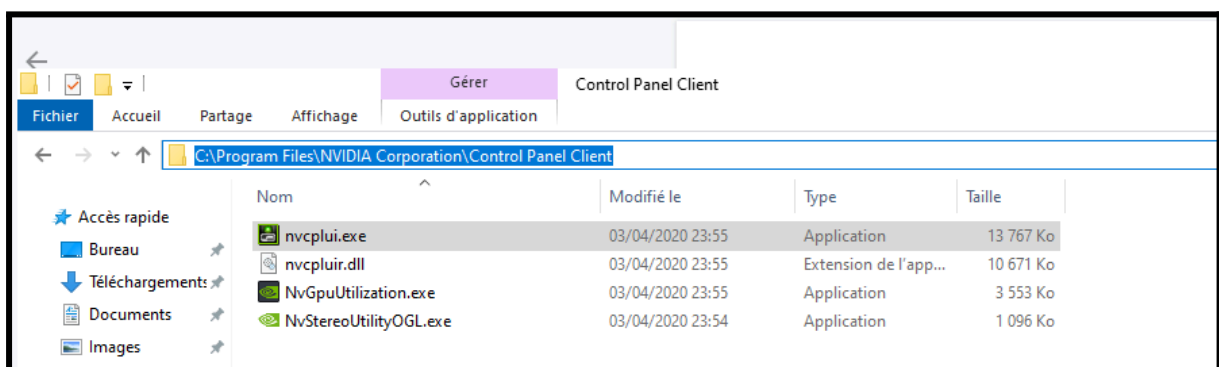
You can access it in the shortcuts at the bottom right of your screen (*Picture 1*) :



Picture 1 : Nvidia control panel via shortcuts

If there is no NVidia shortcut, here is the default folder with the panel exe (*Picture 2*) :
C:\Program Files\NVIDIA Corporation\Control Panel Client

You, then, launch **nvcpui.exe**.

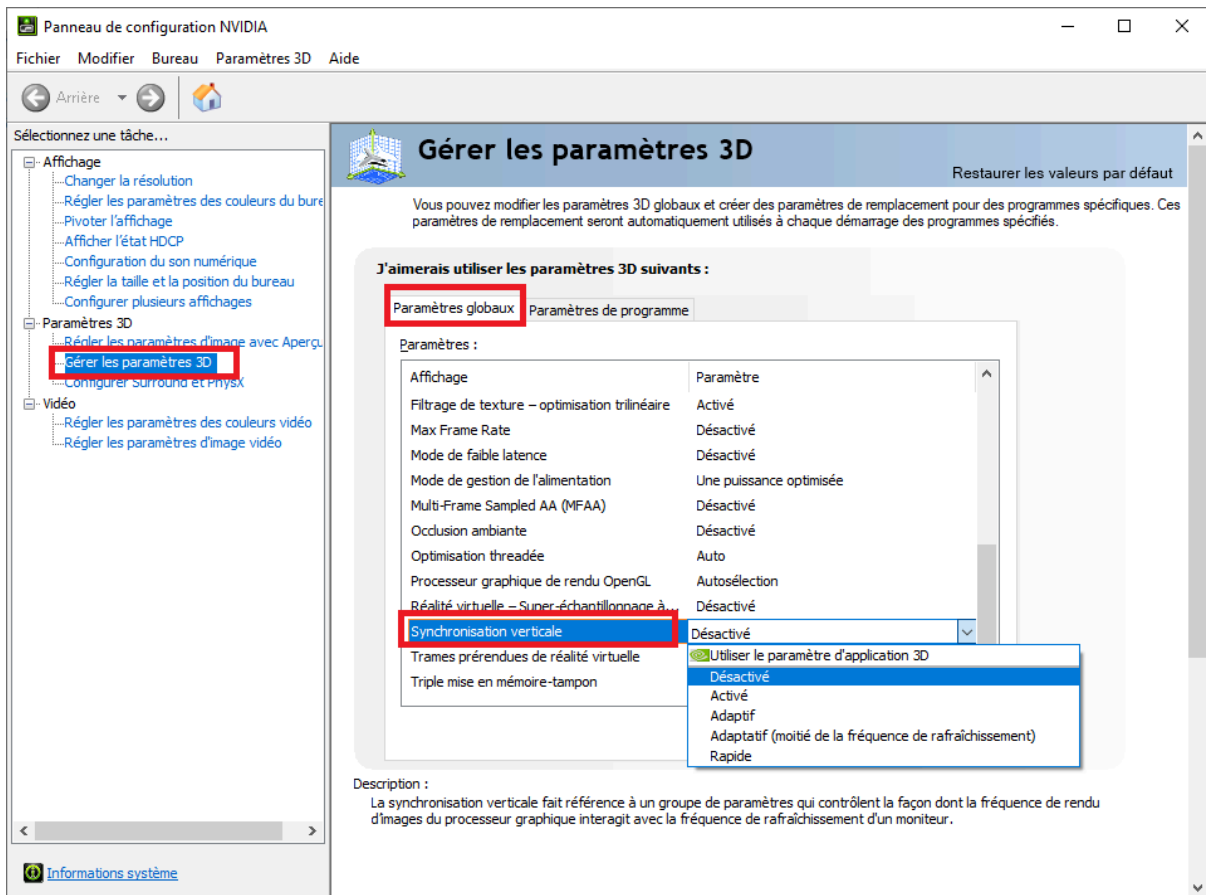


Picture 2 : Nvidia control panel location

- **Change settings**

Once the panel is open (*Picture 3*)

- 1- Select “**Manage 3D settings**” (“Gérer les paramètres 3D” on the screenshot) in the left part of the panel.
- 2- Stay in the “**Global Settings**” (“Paramètres globaux” on the screenshot) tab.
- 3- Scroll down the options and select “**Off**” (“Désactivé” on the screenshot) for the “**Vertical sync**” (“Synchronisation verticale” on the screenshot) setting.
- 4- Click the “Apply” button at the bottom of the panel.
