Problem Statement Checklist

Review your problem statement to see if any area can be strengthened.

- Is the problem clearly stated?
- Is the problem significant?
- Is the problem urgent?
- Is the problem something you have the capacity to solve?
- Have you used language that is specific and descriptive?
- Does the problem statement build in a logical way?
- Have you included the required information including Regional Plan data, LMI data, sector
- Is the problem statement section concise?
- Can you eliminate any unnecessary words?
