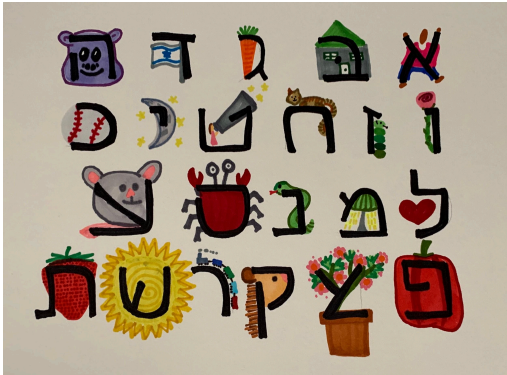


Doodly Jew
