School Responsibility

- Support the policies of Brunswick County Schools, and the expectations of Cedar Grove Middle School, by reviewing the student handbook with the student.

 weekly reviews of a student's Google Classroom and weekly review of Infinite Campus to monitor grades and

- Stay aware of any information and weekly announcements by keeping all contact information up-to-date with the school, attending all school-sponsored conference nights and curriculum nights, and visiting the school's social media sites, weekly, for information. Communication through Dojo, and review of monthly newsletters
- Be clear, open, and respectful in communication with your student's teachers.
