

## **TIMELINE - JULY and AUGUST**

<ul> <li>Log into your account in NAVIANCE STUDENT         https://www.easthamptonschools.org/guidance         <ul> <li>Under "About Me" &gt; "Surveys from your schools" complete the "Class of 2026 Game Plan"</li> <li>Under "Colleges" &gt; "College Home" conduct college searches, utilize graphs and charts to familiarize yourself with college data.</li> <li>Begin to create your list of colleges of interest by clicking the heart icon</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
(these colleges will be listed under "Colleges I'm thinking about")
2. Demonstrate interest: Register on college websites, communicate with Admissions.
3. Schedule campus virtual visits/interviews. Visit the individual college websites for programs and tours. If schools allow, visit in person.
4. Research financial considerations: Tuition, Room and Board, Scholarships, Financial Aid and the required forms (FAFSA/TAP/CSS Profile). Visit <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a>
5. Create/Update test accounts and register for test administration (be aware that some colleges are "test optional")  SAT: www.collegeboard.org ACT: www.actstudent.org (Fee waivers are available for students who have been approved by the district office for Free or Reduced Lunch: contact your counselor for information)
6. Beginning August 1, 2025- Create accounts for college applications:  *Remember to save your login and password information. Use your personal email, not school email when registering these accounts.  • COMMON APPLICATION: <a href="https://www.commonapp.org">www.commonapp.org</a> *utilized by most colleges*

12. Continue to update your resume: Highlight community service activities, awards, athletics, music, drama, leadership achievements, etc. Examples are listed on the counseling website.** <i>Email updated resume to your counselor</i> .
11. Div 1 & Div 2 Athletes - You must create an NCAA account and be aware of the requirements, registration deadlines ( <a href="www.ncaaclearinghouse.org">www.ncaaclearinghouse.org</a> )
10. Music students - Be aware of music audition requirements and deadlines.
9. Art/Architecture students - Be aware of portfolio requirements and deadlines.

✓ <b>Suggestion:</b> Using a calendar (digital or printed), write down all important dates and work backwards to make sure you meet all requirements on time.
