



Alumni Advisory Committee

The Advisory Committees function as a group of volunteer “experts” who provide advice and guidance to the school’s Board of Directors and administrators.

There are several sub-committees of the Alzar School Board, which are chaired by members of the Board of Directors, and often include key school staff as well as specialists in the field. They may include (but are not limited to): Advancement & Parent Association Committee (with a key role in fundraising to support the school and maintaining parental involvement), the Risk Management Committee (with an eye toward mitigating medical and legal risks of programming), the Business & Finance Committee (which guides in managing school funds, including looking at budgets, operating reserves, and the endowment), the Governance Committee (which is dedicated to Board oversight and development), the Education & Curriculum Committee (for the maintenance of academic excellence and innovation), Chilean Programs, Diversity and Inclusion, and others.

Alumni Advisory Committee is comprised of 6 alumni who are ~1 year removed from their Alzar experience. Each May, Alzar School administration will reach out to all recent alums encouraging them to apply for the Alumni Advisory Committee. These 1-year term committee members will meet several times between July and June of the year following their Alzar experience and help with admissions, advancement and alumni relations. Members also gain a deeper understanding behind the inner workings of Alzar School and an non-profit organization.
