Hi, users! Welcome!

Rayls Group (referred to as " Rayls" or "us"), is the controller and responsible for processing your Personal Data.

This Cookie Policy guides your use of both the Landing Page available at www.rayls.com and our main Rayls infrastructure, which is only available to registered customers. Some of the provisions of this Policy may apply only to the Rayls infrastructure, and not to the Landing Page and the other way around.

Please note that this Cookie Policy is a complement to our Privacy Policy. In the Privacy Policy, you will find more detailed information about the concepts we use, and you will fully understand how we collect, use and protect your personal data, as well as being aware of your rights related to this data.

What are cookies?

A cookie is like a small file containing letters and numbers that we store in your browser or on the hard drive of your device used to access our Website.

Targeting cookies	cookies record your visit to our website, including the you visit and the links to them. These cookies are specially ned to collect information from you in order to display ads on related topics of interest. We may share this information nird parties to fulfill this purpose.

Our website uses cookies to identify you from other users. This identification helps us to make your browsing experience on our website more enjoyable and enables us to make improvements to our website.

Cookies can be installed either directly by the websites visited by the user or by third parties related to the Website. Although cookies do not need to be enabled to access the Website, disabling them may limit the use of certain services or prevent the full functionality of the Website as it might not be possible to run certain functions or processes.

What types of cookies we use?

We may use different types of cookies. Below are the categories and why we use them:

Our Website uses necessary cookies, and the legal basis for their collection is our legitimate interest (e.g. for setting a cookie that helps ensure that the content of a page on our Website loads quickly and effectively) or legal obligations (e.g. for setting a cookie that is essential to comply with the security requirements in connection with our services). Other cookies may be used as above with your consent.

Does Rayls share information with third parties using cookies?

No! We do not share the information collected by cookies with third parties. However, it is worth noting that third parties may use cookies over which we have no control. These third parties may include, for example, advertising networks and external service providers, such as web traffic analysis services. These third-party cookies are likely to be analytical, performance or targeting cookies.

When we make third-party content available on our Website, it is likely that cookies from these third parties will also be installed on your devices. We have no control over or responsibility for their use, purpose and operation. We therefore strongly

We also use Google Analytics to help us analyze the use of the website. Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about the use of the website by means of cookies, which are stored by users' browsers on their computers.
