

Weekly Plan (Mar 11th – Mar 15th)

Topic: Phonics, Grammar

Sub-topic: Adjectives- describing words (part 4)

Objectives:

- identify and list adjectives
- use adjectives to build stories
- use pictures as a guide for story writing

Content:

An adjective is a word that modifies or describes a noun or pronoun.

Adjectives in a picture:

A Day at the Park

My mom meets her best friend at the park. She was wearing a yellow shirt and a short red skirt with a pair red heel shoes. Her hair was beautiful. It was in two bunches. I was very happy. I saw my best friends too. We played on the swing and made small sand castles.



Use adjectives to tell this story.

Instruction:

1. Students will do a silly drawing slide picture to use their words and build on adjectives.
2. Students will vote for best drawing.
3. Teacher will review types of adjectives in clues form. (slide will have colors, numbers, size and emojis)
4. Emotions will be the next adjective to cover. Teacher will describe a picture for students to draw. The picture will have colors, number and size. An emotion will be describe so that students can draw the face.
5. Students will get their posters from previous class to continue build on their stories. They will continue to describe what they see taking place in their picture. Teachers will facilitate the class.
6. Students will share what they have gathered with the class as they continue to build their stories.
