- Context to the Constitutional Convention
 - After America won the Revolution, the Articles of Confederation was instilled as the framework of government until 1781
 - In 1787, delegates around the 13 colonies (except Rhode Island) created a Constitutional Convention to discuss a new framework of government
 - Debates over the Constitution led to the Great Compromise which set up Congress into a bicameral legislature (House and Senate)
 - Constitution included the first 10 Amendments called the Bill of Rights
 - **1:** Freedom of speech, press, religion, petition, and assembly
 - **2:** Right to bear arms and militia
 - **3:** No quartering
 - **4:** No unreasonable searches or seizures
 - **5:** Right against self-incrimination (Miranda rights), right to a speedy and fair trial, and eminent domain
 - **6:** Right to a speedy and fair trial, right to lawyer, right to impartial jury
 - **7:** Extends the 6th to non-criminal cases
 - **8:** No cruel or unusual punishments
 - **9:** Enumerated (explicitly stated) rights can be added to the Constitution
 - **10:** Powers not given to the Federal gov't given to the states or the people
