<u>Cubism</u>: Cubism is a style of painting that was developed in the early 1900s.

<u>Cubist paintings show objects from many angles at once. Two main artists, Pablo Picasso and Georges Braque, developed Cubism. They believed that painters should not just present realistic views of subjects. Instead, they wanted to show every part of the whole subject.</u>

<u>Surrealism</u>: is a style in art and literature in which ideas, images, and objects are combined in a strange way, like in a dream.
