	Describe the rhetorical situation and craft choices in your creative piece - discuss exigence, author, purpose, audience, context and message
	State the title and author of the text(s) you studied, using appropriate capitalization and formatting
	What is the author's purpose in the text you studied?
	How does the author use ethos, pathos or logos to develop the message or theme(s) in the text?
	Identify and explain a claim that the author makes in the text.
	Provide evidence to explain how the author supports his/her/their claim in the text.
