Shah Gul Rezaie is a human rights and women rights activist from Afghanistan. Mrs. Rezaie won a parliamentary seat from Ghazni province in the 2005 and 2010 elections. She served as the Chairwoman of the Commission of Oversight and Law Enforcement and a member of various other parliamentary commissions. In addition, she served as a member and chair of Voice of Justice parliamentary group during her term at the parliament of Afghanistan. Mrs. Rezaie was part of the official delegation at the Bonn Conference on Afghanistan in 2001. She was also a member of negotiation team to form the National Unity Government in Afghanistan in 2014. Besides, she took part at the Intra-Afghan Dialogue in 2019 in Doha and the Intra-Afghan Dialogue in 2022 in Oslo.

Mrs. Rezaie has a bachelor degree in law and political sciences and a master's degree in public policy and administration from the Kabul University.
