

Prior Approval for Classroom Use of Videos/Digital Media

In accordance with DPS Board Policy 3205, prior to the presentation of an entire feature length video (defined by the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences, the American Film Institute and the British Institute as 40 minutes or longer), regardless of physical format or source, teachers must complete and submit the *Prior Approval for Videos and Digital Media form* to the principal for approval. The principal may grant blanket approval to any video/digital resource that has been selected and approved for purchase by authorized school or district personnel, or provided through the district software portfolio. Please refer also to <u>Board Policy 3205: Use of Videos and Digital Media</u>.
