

# TikTok: Non-Verbal Communication:

## 10 Non-Verbals to AVOID during an Interview

During an interview, the messages our non-verbal body language convey can speak as loudly and clearly as the words coming out of our mouths!

Your job is to research 10 non-verbal body language examples that should be avoided during an interview. Also include the reason it should be avoided and address the message the non-verbal body language conveys to a prospective employer. When researching, please use and cite at least 3 different reliable resources.

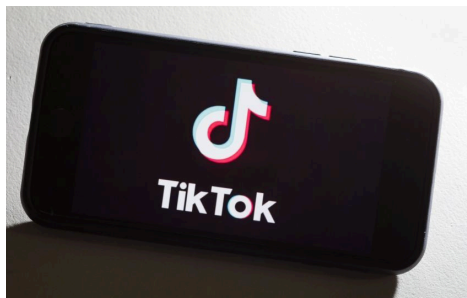
Once your research is complete, you will need to create a TikTok video or a mock TikTok using Flipgrid and the provided template and instructions. If you are making the actual TikTok, you will need the App. Either video option should creatively teach us about 10 non-verbals to avoid during an interview. Be sure that the entire video, including music is school appropriate and the required length.

**You may work individually or with one other person.**

- If you are working individually, your TikTok needs to be a minimum of 15 seconds in length.
- If you are working with a partner, your TikTok needs to be a minimum of 30 seconds in length with both people being featured for 15 seconds each.

On a separate Google Doc you will explain the message each non-verbal body language example conveys and why it should be avoided. You will also cite your web-sources.

You will be provided some class time to research, plan and record your video. Please use it wisely or you will lose it. Also, anything NOT completed in class will have to be done outside of class.
