Format

a.b.c.d (i.e. 1.1.0.25)

(a) Incremented for major releases with sweeping change.

example: replace / retire paper filing method

(b) Incremented for release with substantial new / rewritten functionality.

example: extend electronic filing to support traditional preparers

(c) Incremented for each Monthly Deployment.

example: our deployment on the 15th of each month

(d) Incremented when new commit / deployment is made.

example: defect fix

Note: When higher level number incremented, the lower level numbers are reset to zero. For example, when b is incremented, c and d are reset to zero.
