Registration and Payment:

- Registration opens 3/31 and closes 5/5.
- The cost of camp this year is \$350. Payment is due by 5/5.

Transportation

- Similar to last year, we will have 1 Charter bus to take us to camp Tejas. We ask that everyone please arrive to the church offices by 10am to check-in. At arrival, please go inside church offices to check in. **DO NOT** go straight to the bus.
- **BYOL - Bring your own Lunch**. Whether its a sack lunch or you stop by Chick-Fil-A before heading to the church, you'll want to make sure your students bring a

lunch to have on the bus since the first meal of camp won't be till Dinner.

Arrival:

We hope to leave camp by 12pm on Monday, June 9th. So we expect to arrive back at Church Offices by 5pm.

Camp Packing List:

CAMP MODESTY GUIDELINES

GIRLS:

1. No Spaghetti Straps
2. No Low Cut tops, or shirts that reveal your midriff
3. If leggings are worn you must also have a long-T-shirt or shorts to cover your leggings.
4. Shorts must be an appropriate length (3 inch in-seam or longer) and looseness and not covered by a T-Shirt. No revealing shorts.
5. Swimsuit: One piece with swim shorts or tankini with swim shorts (tops must not be revealing).

GUYS:

1. Shorts must also be an appropriate length and looseness (4 inch in-seam or longer)
2. Tank tops are allowed but no cut offs
3. If not at the pool or lake a T-shirt must be worn at all times.

CAMP ALIVE PACKING LIST

BRING:

- Bible & Pen: A notebook will be provided at camp for notes
- Everyday Clothes: Bring Clothes for 5 days and 4 nights, including active clothes and shoes that can get dirty. Bring a trash bag for wet and dirty laundry.
- Team Gear: Bring clothes for 6 Games in **your team's color**. We have many teams with similar colors.
- Swimsuits: Girls - One piece w/ swim shorts or tankini w/ swim shorts Guys - An appropriate length and looseness.
- Towels: We recommend bring AT LEAST 2 towels. One for the shower, one for swimming and other activities
- Essentials: Shampoo, Conditioner, Deodorant, tooth brush, toothpaste, Sunscreen... ect.
- Bedding: Bring a pillow, sheets, and blanket for the bed or a sleeping bag & pillow.
- Snacks: Feel free to bring snacks
- Water: You must bring a refillable water bottle!
- Money: Bring money to spend at the camp store and snack shop (optional).
- Misc.: Flashlight, Bug Spray, and Wristwatch (To be able to tell the time because no phones are allowed)
- Disposable Cameras: Smart Phones will not be allowed so bring a disposable camera if you want to take pictures at camp. There will be a camp photographer.

DON'T BRING:

- **Weapons:** This includes but is not limited to pocket knives. No making weapons at camp either.
- **Drugs:** Alcohol, tobacco, and all other illegal substances are included.
- **Phones & Electronics:** In order to encourage fellowship and minimize distractions we will not be allowing phones or electronics of any kind at camp. If these items are brought & used without leaders permission will be confiscated.

Camp Rules:

- Parents, please review the rules before camp. These rules will be reviewed with the students before camp and on the 1st day of camp.

CAMP RULES

THE EXPECTATIONS

We want you to have fun during camp, and we want you to live to tell others about it. Here are some rules we have for you to help make that happen.

- **Be at Everything Wholeheartedly:** If there is something on the schedule, it isn't optional! After night activities please go to your cabin and stay there.
- **No Ring. No thing:** "Special relationships" are not allowed to at camp. Any crossing of the line in this area will result in being immediately sent home, at your parent's expense. Friendships are allowed but all guy/girl interactions must be appropriate and in group settings.
- **Respect and Obey the Leaders:** If a leader asks you to do something (even if they aren't your leader), do it without giving them a hard time and do it with a good attitude.
- **Competition:** Our games crew has worked hard to make the games as fun, safe, and as fair as possible. Please be patient with them as they referee the games and try your best to maintain a Christlike attitude while playing (Col. 3:23).
- **Respect the Camp Property:** The goal is to leave the camp as it was when you got here. If you break something your parents will pay for it, so please respect the property while at camp.
- **No Pranks:** Unless they are approved by Chance Hunt (he does not approve pranks... good luck)
- **Be Modest:** If you did not bring swimwear or clothes that is in accordance with the packing list, speak to your small group leader so they can help you. If a small group leader notices an issue with clothing you will be asked to change. Girls: shorts should be an appropriate length and looseness and not completely covered by a shirt. Guys: your shorts should be an appropriate length and looseness. If not at the pool or lake, a shirt must be worn at all times.

- **Buddy System:** At all times, there needs to be at least one other person of the same gender. If you are at a group activity, please inform a leader if you and a buddy need to leave the group. If there is a group of mixed genders then there must be at least two of each gender present in the group.
- **Smartphones and Electronics:** In order to encourage fellowship and minimize distractions, smartphones and electronics are not allowed at camp. If you violate these rules, expect a leader to ask for your device. You will receive it back at the end of camp.
- **Pool and Lake:** Each student must follow the rules or else they will be asked to sit out of the water activities. In order to swim in the pool or lake, there must be a leader and lifeguard present.
- **Cabins and Rooms:** You should never be alone in a cabin or in a cabin that is not your own unless otherwise approved by a leader. Your bed is your personal space, no one should ever be on your bed other than yourself. Cabins and Rooms are shared spaces, please be respectful of other people's items and place all trash in a trash can. Once it is time to be in cabins or rooms you must remain inside them (get water before you come to the cabin). At lights out, all lights will be turned off whether or not you have showered or used the bathroom. If you plan to leave the cabin earlier than 8:00, you must arrange that with a leader.

EXPECTATION FAILURE

You will receive one warning after a rule violation. If we do not see a change after the first warning, your parents will be contacted. If you are still unable to meet these expectations after this phone call your parents will be contacted again and you will be sent home immediately. If you are caught pairing off with another student of the opposite sex in a secluded area, your parents will be contacted and you will be sent home immediately.

- Cell phones are **NOT** allowed.
- The charter bus has lots of space for storage, try to fit all in one suitcase for easier movement from bus to cabin.

- No ring no thing “special” relationships are not allowed.

Any crossing of the line will result in being immediately sent home at parents expense.

- Fevers will also be required for pick up from camp.

Prayer Requests:

- That the students will set aside any distractions and be ready to listen and respond to the word of God being taught.
- For the students who don't know the Lord, that their hearts would be opened to the truth of the gospel.
- That the Holy Spirit would give the various camp speakers clarity and accuracy.

- That the small groups would be beneficial to the spiritual growth of the students.
- That all the students will apply the practical applications heard in the sermon and discussed in small groups.
- That the Lord would provide the staff abundant strength and energy to make it through camp.
- That all students and staff would remain healthy and safe throughout the duration of camp.
