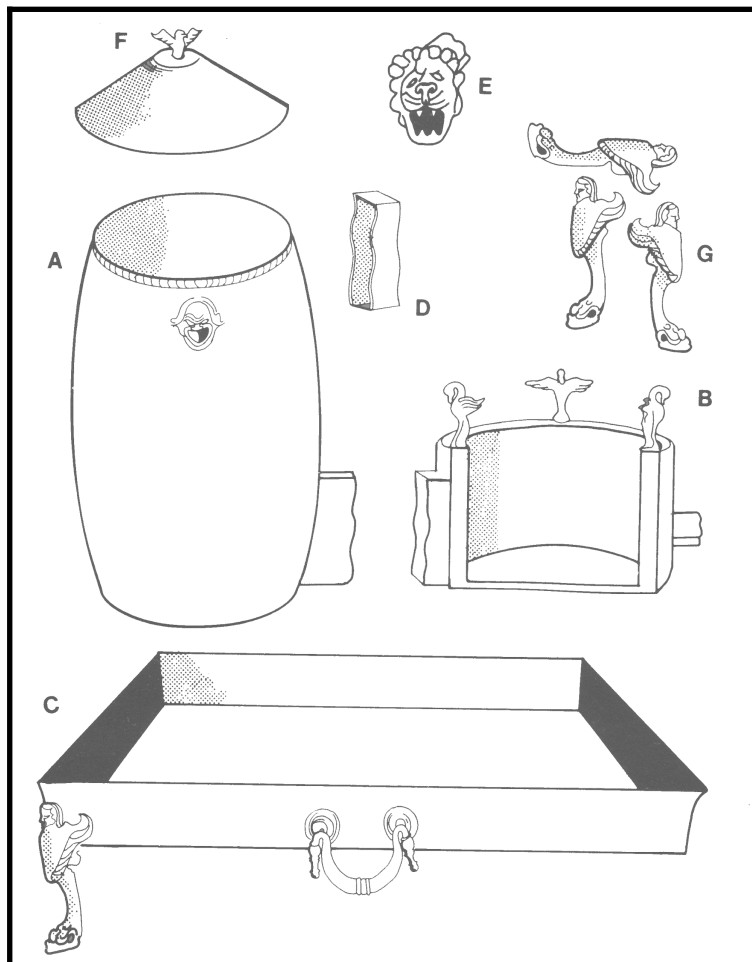


15. What's it for?
