
Climate Change Proposals

Your task for this assignment is to:

- 1. Identify a specific policy that will allow the United States to either mitigate the effects of climate change or adapt to them

Creative Formats

- Short film or commercial (between 30 and 90 seconds max)
- Song (performed)
- Graphic novel, comic strip or cartoon.
- Prezi (preferred over power point)
- Other

Evaluation

- Proposal/Policy should be clear and effective.
- Proposal/Policy should be supported by fact and opinion.
- Projects should be creative and have artistic merit.
- Projects should be your own work.
