Do you want to be one of the best Heroes of the Storm players in the world? Are you eager to join a pro team, compete in tournaments, and take your gaming career to the next level?

DISCLAIMER:

Before you apply, please understand that we are not looking for semi-pro players. We are looking for players that are ambitious, passionate, and truly dedicated, who continuously strive to be the best.

We are looking to form a North American team that will compete in as many community tournaments as possible in the upcoming months, and forge a name for ourselves as one of the best teams in the world.

Our long term goal is to become a fully sponsored, professional team. What that means is we are looking for players that are willing to dedicate a minimum of 20 hours a week to practicing. This is a serious commitment, so think carefully before you pull the trigger and apply.

Remember that playing solo queue all day and practicing with a team are two entirely different things, both of which are important. So aside from solo practice, we will have multiple team practice sessions a week.

There are already multiple well-known and established e-sport organizations who have already invested a lot into HotS, and all signs indicate that this game will be HUGE in the competitive scene in the near future.

If you truly love Heroes of the Storm and believe you can be one of the best in the world, then the time has never been better to establish your name on the competitive scene.

With that said, if you think you have what it takes, apply below!

Minimum, basic requirements:

- At least 18 years old (exceptions made for EXCEPTIONALLY skilled applicants).
- Notable accomplishments in other games/high level of play background experience. If you never achieved a high ranking or played at a high level in any game, then you are probably not the type of person we are looking for.
- Deep knowledge of the game - level 40 account in Heroes, at least hundreds of games played, high MMR on hotlogs (due to ambiguous ladder that atm is fan-made, this is not so important). Lackluster experience in Heroes might be overlooked for remarkable applicants [with strong interest in HotS] that were professional players in another game.
- Available for tournaments on weekends
- We will communicate in English, thus being able to speak and understand English fluently is required.
- Serious, mature, and professional attitude. And most important of all, positive, meaning you have to be able to take constructive criticism well coming from other members of the team. There will be zero tolerance for ragers or rage quitting.

Major pluses:

- Rank 1 High Hero League ranking (with good win/loss ratio)
- High level experience in other major MOBAs (high MMR in Dota2, Diamond+ in League)

10. Elaborate on your experience with HotS. What is your current Hero League rank and win/loss ratio? How many total games played? What role are you planning on mastering? Are you open to the idea of playing a different one and if yes, which one?
11. In your own time, when not practicing with the team, how do you think you could improve your skills?
12. Social media links.
13. Are you a streamer? If yes, are you fine with not streaming when we practice as a team? Provide your twitch.tv link.
14. Link your computer specs.
15. Do you have a stable connection at all times? Please run a speed test (<http://www.speedtest.net/>) and provide a link to it.
16. Lastly, tell us more about yourself! Other interests, hobbies, or commitments. Prying is not our intention, we simply would like to know what other real life obligations you might have (such as school, a job, a girlfriend, a wife, etc) that might affect your normal schedule.
