SECTION 1: INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the [**P2 100 Initial Implementation Video**](#)! We are excited for you to get your school started (or refreshed) with The Positivity Project (P2) by leading a successful training. To help you, we've created this short facilitator guidebook.

As a reminder, the purpose of the P2 100 Video is to train your school's entire staff in 3 hours or less. Please note that you can use this training to lead a virtual training session for your staff if you're not meeting in person.

NOTE: At the completion of the training, there is a [**P2 100 Survey and Quiz**](#). After completing this survey, P2 will send each individual survey taker a certificate of completion to assist in documentation and credit for professional development hours.

Enabling your fellow staff members to understand the research driving P2 and how to implement it successfully is a key step in the Partner School journey, and we believe this course will help you achieve those goals.

It will feature an opening "Founding Story" video, followed by eight (8) separate videos of P2 co-founder Mike Erwin directly teaching the research behind positive psychology, character strengths, and the importance of relationships. **Following Mike's videos, we have included a resource overview to assist your staff in understanding the resources included in your partnership.**

Additionally, we have "P2 in Action" at partner elementary, middle, and high schools. Using P2 in Action videos of your choice will be a great way to show your school's staff members what P2 implementation looks like — and the impact effective implementation has on students.

Your responsibility as the facilitator will be to play each of the videos embedded in the Google Slide deck — and then guide discussions in a think-pair-share format at the end of each designated video. It is recommended that you complete this as a live training session, whether in person or virtually.

These discussions are critical to attendees' understanding of the importance of P2 and how to implement it in the classroom. We recommend a Partner School's principal and P2 Leader co-facilitate the training — but feel free to do what you think is best.

In this guide, you will find instructions on how to facilitate, recommended pre-work for course facilitators, recommended pre-work for attendees, and appendices with draft email templates.



SECTION 2: How to Facilitate

1. **Room setup.** We've designed this training to be as simple as possible for you, the facilitator, with videos of Mike directly teaching the research driving the P2. However, to make it effective, you must have: (a) an internet connection to play the videos, (b) a large enough screen for everyone to see the videos, and (c) loud enough sound for everyone to hear the videos. We also recommend you group attendees in tables of between 4–8 people for effective use of the think-pair-share format.
 - a. **NOTE:** We know that you may need to lead this virtually. If that's the case, no problem! You can either play the videos on your computer and share your screen with attendees or share the Google Slides presentation and have them play each video on their own. Then, after watching the video, you can reconvene and discuss what you just watched.
2. **Present, Press Play, and Think-Pair-Share.** Your job as the facilitator is to open the [P2 100 Video Google Slides presentation](#), press play on the Founding Story Video and each of Mike's eight (8) videos (in sequential order from Section 1–8), and then facilitate discussion in a think-pair-share format at the end of each designated video. Please feel free to add discussion questions that are unique to your audience should you pre-plan them.
3. **Special Notes on Videos.** All videos have questions for discussion, following each video. Facilitators are encouraged to review the questions in advance and supplement when/if necessary. The structure is predictable. Participants should fill out the [P2 100 Survey and Quiz](#) at the end of the training in order to document completion and professional development hours. Discussion promotes understanding but also connection. Make time to allow participants to engage with the content, discuss with their colleagues, and develop their own connections to the content. This will establish a firm foundation for P2 implementation.



SECTION 3: RECOMMENDED PRE-WORK FOR COURSE FACILITATORS

1. **Watch.** Course facilitators watch the [entire series of videos](#) ahead of time — including the Founding Story, all videos of Mike teaching, and P2 Resource Access. You know your staff members better than anyone, so you can decide which P2 in Action videos will be the most useful. And, as an extra tool for your prep, we've provided the slides Mike presents in the P2 100 Video and accompanying notes. The slides and notes are available here: [P2 100 Video Facilitator Notes](#).
2. **Know - P2 Implementation Strategy.** Before leading the staff-wide training, you should have a plan for how you will implement the P2 school-wide and in classrooms. To help you, we've created a 1-Page Implementation planning tool and New and Returning Partner School Beginning of Year Implementation Checklists.
